



Blossburg Memorial Library Wireless Internet Acceptable Use Policy

The Blossburg Memorial Library offers free Wireless Internet access ('WiFi') for library patrons and/or visitors to use on their own personal laptops and other mobile devices.

To connect to our wireless network, Library Wifi Open, select the network and launch your web browser. A wireless login screen will appear, and you will need to accept the Terms of Use.

By signing into the wireless network, users agree to abide by the Blossburg Memorial Library Computer and Internet Use Policy.

Be aware that the wireless network is not secure. Information sent from or to your device may be captured or monitored by others. The Library recommends that you do not use a public network to transmit personal or financial data. We also recommend that you disable file sharing while using the network. The Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of your computer or wireless device or their configurations resulting from connection to the Library's wireless access. It is advised that you keep antivirus and spyware software up to date on your personal devices. The Library will not be responsible for any information (i.e., a credit card) that is compromised, or for any damage caused to your hardware or software due to electric surges, security issues or consequences caused by viruses or hacking.

Library staff and volunteers are not able to provide technical assistance. Patrons are responsible for the setup and configuration of their own equipment. The Library cannot accept the liability of changing settings on your devices and computer equipment, however will advise on connecting to the wireless network. If you require further technical assistance, you may need to contact your hardware or software manufacturer.

All users are expected to use the Library's wireless access in a legal and responsible manner, consistent with the educational and informational purposes for which it is provided. Internet users are asked to respect the privacy of other users. Abusive or illegal activities are forbidden while using the Library's Internet service. Patrons may lose their library privileges and use of the Library's WiFi if they willfully participate in these activities.

Any restriction or monitoring of a minor's access to the Library's wireless network is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.

Most public areas of the Library, including the Community Room, are serviced by the wireless network, but there may be areas where the signal is weak. If you feel that the wireless reception is inadequate, try moving to another location within the Library.

Wireless printing is not available at this time. You may save your information to a flash drive or e-mail and sign into a public computer to print at a cost of 25 cents per page. You may have to wait for an available computer.

Laptops and other devices should never be left unattended in the Library, even for brief periods of time. The Library assumes no responsibility for damage, theft, or loss of any kind to a user's equipment, software, data files or other personal property brought into or used in the Library.
